## Sponsors

This weekend retreat is open to Unitarian Universalists and their friends. It is organized by volunteers from several UU congregations in the St. Lawrence District.

## Cost

Several lodging/meal options are available. See table on other side for prices. Note that child is defined as 6 – 17 years old, sharing parent's room. Age 5 and under are free. Lodging assignments will be made based on date of registration and deposit. ♦ Rooms on the third floor of the Inn (Option C, D, E, or F) have limited or no heat. ♦ Two bedroom cottages hold 4+ people, three BR cottage hold 6+, 4 BR 8+. ♦ The Inn and dining room are handicapped accessible. ♦ All meals from Saturday breakfast through Sunday lunch are included. ♦ An optional buffet is available on Friday evening for those who can arrive between 5:30 and 8:15 p.m.

**Children's pricing:** Kids ages 6-17 are about \$50 less than the adult rate for same type of room—see price list on other side. Kids age 5 and under are free. Each room must have one person paying adult rate.

## Refunds and Deadlines

A non-refundable deposit of \$50 for each adult and child (ages 6-17) is due when making reservations. **Reservations received by Sept. 21 qualify for lower room rates.** The balance is due by Oct. 2. Refunds will be made, except for deposits, if written notification is received prior to noon, Oct. 5.

If special accommodations are needed you must register before Sept. 21. **Pets are not allowed at Silver Bay.**

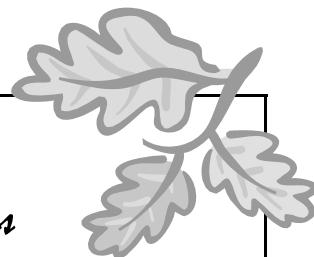
